A charge of £30 per week for central heating - if at any time that you feel that heating would be nice simply make arrangements with and pay the local property manager.

Other useful information (short version!)

The house has **satellite TV**, simply bring your Sky or free-to-air viewing card.

Rubbish - the wheelie bin is emptied on Monday. Please bag everything. There is glass recycling in the opposite direction to the bar at the crossroads.

There should be a spare **gas** cylinder behind the door in the garage but if not they come from the Amitie bar in the village.

Shopping and opening hours - Evelyn at the bar Amitie sells basics including bread and milk and Olivier at the little supermarket in Plumaudan (turn right out of the drive) sells a good range. Nearly everything is closed on Sundays, but a nice little Coci market in Caulnes is open Sunday morning. Monday morning finds many shops still closed but the big Supermarkets are back in action. Remember that lunchtime is sacred and even quite big shops may close.

The nearest **cash machine** is at the LeClerc in Dinan, in an office at the right hand end of the building.

Cars - Feu Vert, opposite LeClerc, is the equivalent of Halfords but more versatile, and is the first place to try if you have car problems. **Petrol** is commonly available at all hours from automated pumps that take payment by credit card (as long as it is 'chip and PIN').
